Montgomery Blair High School Athletic Hall of Fame

2022 marks the launching of Montgomery Blair High School's long-overdue Athletic Hall of Fame. **The Blair Athletic Department and the Blair Alumni Association are co-sponsoring this new organization.**

The purpose of the Blair Athletic Hall of Fame is to celebrate Blair's enduring legacy of achievements in athletics, and to recognize the outstanding athletes, teams, coaches, and administrators who have built that legacy and added immeasurably to the Blair experience.

The inaugural induction of MBHS Athletic Hall of Fame members will be held in the Fall of 2022 at a ceremony to take place in ALUMNI HALL at Montgomery Blair. The date will be determined shortly.

Qualifications for HOF Inductees

1. Must have graduated from Blair more than 10 years prior to induction
2. If not a Blair graduate, must have lettered in varsity athletics for at least 2 years while at Blair
3. Recognition/induction will be based on athletic achievements both while at Blair and after graduation from Blair, with an emphasis on Blair-related achievements
4. Teams will be recognized on a group basis
5. The inaugural group will be limited to athletes & teams, with coaches, administrators, and special consideration inductees added starting in the second year.
6. Athletes who have been previously inducted into the Blair Alumni Association Hall of Fame will be automatically added the inaugural class of the new Athletic Hall of Fame.

The athletes currently included in this group are:

Steve Barber (1956) – Baltimore Orioles Hall of Fame Pitcher; 1966 World Series Winner

Dr. Malcolm Beasley (1957) – First Team All Met Basketball; Prize Winning Physicist

Tom Brown (1958) – 2 time Super Bowl Champion; Football and Baseball All Metro & All American

Dr. Richard Brown (1955) – Most Successful Athlete at Blair; Trained over 100 Olympic Athletes

Sonny Jackson (1961) – First Team All Met Basketball & Baseball; 40-year Major League Career

John Klippstein (1945) – First Blair grad in MLB; 13-year career; 1959 World Series Winner

Brian Magid (1975) - First Team All Met basketball; 1975 State Championship Team

Bob Windsor (1961) – First Team All Met Football & Basketball; 12 Year NFL Career

Morgan Wooten (1950) – Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame Inductee; 50 year coaching career
